Welcome Migratory Birds

Woodland Dunes is a 1300-acre nature preserve of globally significant habitat. Each season offers opportunities: in spring, enjoy returning birds; in summer, explore the blooming prairie and butterfly garden; in autumn, take in the colors of the fall season; in winter, snowshoe or ski as you explore the preserve.

The [Annual Bird Breakfast and Migration Celebration](#) on **May 10**, features a delicious ham and pancake breakfast, plus a morning full of fun. Learn about wild birds during bird banding demonstrations, enjoy guided bird and nature hikes. Kid's games and activities will be on-going throughout the morning. Fun for the entire family!

After breakfast stay for [Remembering a Lost Bird: Lessons from the Past for a Sustainable Future](#). Learn about the Passenger Pigeon and how in 1914 the last surviving Passenger Pigeon past away at the Cincinnati Zoo. This tragic story of mass extinction offers a "teachable moment" about the world's relationship with other species.

Alpaca Odyssey

[LondonDairy Alpacas](#) reside on a family farm that dates back to 1877. At that time the farm's livestock species included chickens, turkeys, pigs and dairy cows and they delivered processed milk in a horse drawn wagon to customers in the area. At its peak the farm cared for over 200 cattle and 250 chickens. Alpaca fever struck in 1996 with the purchase of four alpacas. Since then Wade Gease and Kevin Stoer have produced prize winning Alpacas and Alpaca fiber products.

Visit on **May 25** for [Alpaca Odyssey](#). Bring the whole family out to an enchanting day at an alpaca farm. See spinning demos, learn about alpaca care or just hug one of the babies. There will be vendors with finished alpaca products, hand knit clothing, and decorative home accents, and live music. Pick out some unusual perennials for the garden and get some incredible alpaca manure for your special plants!
